Bobitic is a cuckoo floor clock of unique and important elegance, when placed in a room it resembles a "presence"™, like a friend that tells the time and marks the days, adding original design and style to the room. The idea was developed by the designer Manuel Barbieri who, remembering his childhood companion, Bobi, a cuddly toy, wanted to transmit through this clock the comforting presence Bobi was for him and at the same time create a useful object of contemporary design whose features go beyond those of a simple clock. The front and rear parts of Bobitic are made of wood, varnished in a smoked oak shade. The rest of the structure is a rich orange colour. The cuckoo mechanism is situated in the upper part, just above the hands of the clock. The Cuckoo strike is switched off automatically during the night controlled by a light sensor.
