The Peek-a-Koo cuckoo clock designed by Krit Jiratkaruen changes the perspective for this type of clock. We are used to seeing the bird come out of the centre of the clock, but, in this case, it comes out from the side toward the middle of the face. It is a clock with a captivating shape thanks to a combination of soft lines that, when paired with angular details, make it something completely new. It has been created with unique working methods and materials and comes in two colour variations. The insert in solid walnut adds a touch of elegance. Painted with non-toxic paints. The high-quality, German-designed cuckoo movement is powered by two batteries, a light sensor prevents the cuckoo from calling when it is dark. A switch allows the sound to be regulated or switched off completely.
